

RESPONSIBLE TOURISM POLICY

Being aware of the importance of maintaining sustainable tourism development, and in line with the principles and objectives specifically adopted at the World Sustainable Development Summit 2015, COP 21 and the World Charter for Sustainable Tourism + 20, the **Consortium of the Museu d'Art Contemporani de Barcelona** is committed to the sustainable management of its activities by assuming commitments aimed at preventing, eliminating or reducing the impact of our facilities and activities, both internal and external, as well as optimising the sustainability of the premises by improving all aspects of its activities with respect to the environment.

In the same spirit, we have adopted the following Responsible Tourism Policy, by means of which we undertake to comply with the requirements established in the BIOSPHERE membership, which includes, among other things, the legal requirements that regulate the effects generated by touristic activities.

Likewise, we are committed to motivating and educating our staff with training and awareness initiatives on the principles of Responsible Tourism, to promote good practices in the environment and participate in external activities, and to report both internally and externally on the progress and environmental actions of the organisation.

In the same way, we pledge ourselves to an express commitment to fight against sexual exploitation or any other form of commercial exploitation and harassment, in particular of children, adolescents, women and minorities; and we are committed to adopting universal accessibility measures.

One of our main objectives is to improve sustainable management, maintaining a commitment to continuous improvement in all areas of sustainability: social, economic and environmental, together with visitor satisfaction. To this end, future expansion projects of facilities or activities will be subject to sustainability and efficiency criteria in the use of resources.

This Responsible Tourism Policy will be periodically updated, adopting and publishing new sustainability objectives whenever circumstances require.
